Approved Bats for 2020 Season

Updated: February 6, 2020

All bats **MUST** have the following stamp in order to be considered legal in the WMSPL.



Exception: Wooden softball bats do not have to be stamped with a BPF of 1.20 and may be used and are legal in all WMSPL play. Wooden bats need to be marked "OFFICIAL SOFTBALL" by the manufacturer. The WMSPL will decide on any necessary grandfathering that will need to be done prior to the start of each season.

NOTE Banned bats from the following association(s) will take precedence over lists where the bat may be approved and will not be allowed in the WMSPL. The link(s) below show the banned bats (as of February 6, 2020):
